Rules The races will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing 2017 – 2020, IJCA Rules, and this Notice of Race Series.

Class rule C.5.1 (Portable Equipment – Mandatory) will remain in effect (for safety reasons), while Class rule C.5.2 (Portable Equipment – Optional) may be disregarded.

B.3.1 & B.3.2 are not in effect for the series (weight certificates and inventory documentation). C.2.1 & C.2.3 are not in effect, (crew limitations).

Entries & Eligibility

J/24 Class Only – The Series is open to all J/24 yachts as defined by the IJCA and whose entries are accepted by the organizer ("Competitors").

Entry Fee is \$0.00.

Crewmembers are not required to be class members. However, they are encouraged to join in support of the class by becoming Associate Members (\$35 per year).

* Saturday, February 2, 2019 - J/24 Off-Season Series # 4 2:00 PM Warning for First Race of the Day

* Saturday, February 9, 2019 - J/24 Off-Season Series # 5 2:00 PM Warning for First Race of the Day

* Saturday, February 16, 2019 - J/24 Off-Season Series # 6 2:00 PM Warning for First Race of the Day

* Saturday, February 23, 2019 - J/24 Off-Season Series # 7 2:00 PM Warning for First Race of the Day

Racing up to two (2) races will be scheduled at each Saturday listed in the schedule. Racing will be windward/leeward courses or variations thereof. Offset weather marks and leeward gates may be used. All races will be scored using the Low Point System, see Rule 90.3(a).

Series Scoring RRS Appendix A, as modified herein, will apply after substituting "Saturday" for "race".

Only those Saturdays for which at least one (1) race is completed will be scored in the overall Series scoring.

If five (5) or fewer races are scored, then no scores will be excluded. If six (6) races are scored, each team's worst score will be excluded. If twelve (12) races are scored, each team's worst two (2) scores will be excluded.

Helmsperson and Helmsperson Substitutions There will be no restrictions on helmsperson substitutions, except that scores are calculated for each boat entered in the series and not the helmsperson. If a person helms more than one boat during the series, then the scores will be calculated separately for each boat and not combined for a composite score for the helmsperson.
