1. Introduction

The 2020 J24 Fleet 21 COVID Series 1 will consist of at most eight (8) races, with all eight (8) races counted for the overall series. The design of this series gives some flexibility. If we happen to complete the 8 races in the first 4 weekends, then we can plan for the next series on the next available weekend. These informal "beer can" style races and potentially windward/leeward style races are designed to get J24 Fleet 21 members of AYC back out onto the water again after a long period of being at home.

2. Classes

This series will be comprised of the following 3 classes:

- Racing Spinnaker class (J24)
- Shorthanded class (may use Spinnaker) (J24 Short Handed)
- Singlehanded class (may use Spinnaker) (J24 Single Handed)

Each class will be scored separately. Order of completion within the class defines the scores.

3. Race Dates and Meetings

- 3.1. Racing concludes for COVID Series #1 after eight (8) races are completed or the dates are expired.
- 3.2. Start times are subject to change based upon updates from the 8:00 AM Zoom meeting.

11. Changes in Sailing Instructions

11.1. Changes in Sailing Instructions (if any) will be added to the <u>on-line official notice board</u>.

11.2. Changes will be discussed in the Competitor's Briefing before each racing event.

12. Signals Made Ashore

12.1. There will be no signals made ashore.

13. Communications

13.1. VHF Channel 78 will be used for on-the-water communications

14. Class Flag

14.1. There will be no class flag.

15. Checking In, Checking Out

15.1. There is no Checking In

15.2. There is no Checking Out.

16. The Course

- 16.1. The specific course will be discussed and decided at each Competitor's briefing depending on expected windspeed, wind direction, and attendees.
- 16.2. The course will potentially be made up of LCRA Marks 4,5,6,7, and potentially AYC Mark D or Windward/Leeward courses.
- 16.3. The specific courses will be discussed at each competitor's briefing and will be posted on the <u>on-line official notice</u> <u>board</u> between the competitor's briefing completion and the start time of the race.

17. Obstructions

17.1. Marked swimming areas

17.2. Marked low water areas

18. The Start

18.1. Race Committee will not be used for these races.

- 18.2. The starting line is between courtesy marks provided by the Austin Yacht Club..
- 18.3. The time of start of the first race will be reviewed at each competitor's briefing and will be posted on the official on-line official notice board between the competitor's briefing completion and the start time of the race.

18.4. Subsequent races in any given day will also be communicated via VHF 78 and agreed to by the competitors.

19. Recalls

19.1. There will be no Recalls.

19.2. If a competitor finds themselves over early at time of the start, they are required to re-start.

20. The Finish

20.1. The finish line is the same as the start line.

21. Time Limit

21.1. The time limit will be discussed and decided at each competitor's briefing and will be posted on the official <u>on-line</u> <u>official notice board</u> between the competitor's briefing completion and the start time of the race.

22. Scoring

- 22.1. One race must be completed to count as a series.
- 22.2. No race scores will be excluded. This modifies RRS A2.
- 22.3. Scores will be posted at the following <u>on-line location</u>.
- 22.4. If a competitor wishes to be scored, he/she may attend the post-race Zoom social and scoring session or may alternatively send an email to <u>captain@j24fleet21.org</u> or send a text message to +1 512.983.2582 with name, boat, and placement by end of each race day identifying the scoring position of his/her boat.

23. Penalty System

- 23.1. Competitors shall use Rule 44 as described in the rules.
- 23.2. Section 44.3 (Scoring Penalty) will not be used.

24. Protests

- 24.1. There shall be no formal protests.
- 24.2. If there are disagreements, all parties to the disagreement shall discuss the situation and come to a conclusion. If no conclusion is reached, all parties involved receive a DSQ for the race.

25. Haul-Out Restrictions

25.1. There are no Haul-Out Restrictions.

26. Diving Equipment, Plastic Pools and Careening Restrictions

26.1. There are not rules for these topics.

27. Crew Substitution or Sail Replacement

27.1. Class rules do not apply. Crew may be substituted throughout the series. 27.2. Alternative sails may be used.

28. Equipment and Measurement Checks

28.1. There will be no Equipment or Measurement Checks for this series.

29. Awards

29.1. Participation awards will be given to those that participate and pay their 2020 J24 Fleet 21 dues.

30. COVID-19: By participating, all competitors agree to abide by the rules, regulations, recommendations, guidance, and policies of the Austin Yacht Club, including any and all COVID-19 related safety measures required by the Austin Yacht Club.
